The journey reaches its peak in the Northern Serengeti during the migration season, where dramatic river crossings and predator action create some of the most intense wildlife moments on earth. Carefully structured travel days ensure you have enough time in each region to fully absorb the experience without rush, allowing for both relaxation and deep immersion in nature.

DAY 1

17th Sept 2026: Arusha National Park – Walking Safari Experience

Your safari begins in the lush landscapes of Arusha National Park, one of the few places in Tanzania where walking safaris are possible. Accompanied by an armed ranger, you will explore the forested slopes, lakes, and open plains while experiencing wildlife at very close range. Expect encounters with giraffes, buffalo, zebras, and possibly colobus monkeys in their natural habitat. This is a perfect gentle introduction to the Tanzanian wilderness.

DAY 2

18th Sept: Arusha – Tarangire National Park (Scenic Drive)

After breakfast, depart Arusha for Tarangire National Park. The journey itself is part of the experience, passing through vibrant local villages, rolling Maasai lands, and scenic countryside views. You will arrive in Tarangire in the afternoon for a relaxed game drive before heading to your lodge or camp. This slow-paced entry allows you to settle into safari rhythm while spotting wildlife along the way.

DAY 3

19th Sept: Full Day Tarangire National Park

Spend a full day exploring Tarangire National Park, famous for its large elephant herds and ancient baobab trees. The Silalei Swamp area is a highlight, especially during the dry season when it attracts massive concentrations of wildlife including lions, giraffes, wildebeest, and a variety of bird species. The Tarangire River acts as a lifeline for animals, offering excellent photography and game viewing opportunities throughout the day.

DAY 4

20th Sept: Tarangire – Serengeti National Park (Via Ngorongoro Highlands)

After breakfast, depart Tarangire and journey towards the legendary Serengeti National Park. The drive takes you through the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, with breathtaking crater highlands and sweeping landscapes.

You will enjoy a game drive en route as you enter the Serengeti plains in the afternoon. Arrive at your camp in time for sunset in one of Africa's most iconic wilderness areas.

DAY 5

21st Sept: Full Day Serengeti (Central Seronera Region)

Today is dedicated to exploring the Central Serengeti, also known as the Seronera Valley. This region is rich in wildlife year-round due to the permanent water sources. Expect excellent sightings of lions, leopards, cheetahs, hyenas, elephants, and large herds of plains game. The open plains and river systems make it one of the best areas for big cat encounters in Africa.

Accommodation: Robin Camp - Serengeti

DAY 6

22nd Sept: Central Serengeti – Northern Serengeti (Migration Route)

After breakfast, depart for the Northern Serengeti with a game drive en route. This region becomes especially dramatic during the migration season. In September, the Mara River crossings are at their peak, offering one of the most powerful wildlife spectacles in the world. Thousands of wildebeest and zebras gather at the riverbanks while crocodiles wait in the waters below, creating unforgettable moments of survival in the wild.

Accommodation: Serengeti Heritage Camp - Mara River

DAY 7

23rd Sept: Full Day Northern Serengeti (Mara River Area)

Spend a full day in the Northern Serengeti focusing on the Mara River crossing points. Patience is key here, as wildlife movements can change quickly, but the rewards are extraordinary. Witness herds gathering, dramatic crossings, and predator action along the riverbanks. This is one of the most intense and emotional wildlife experiences in Africa.

Accommodation: Serengeti Heritage Camp

DAY 8

24th Sept: Northern Serengeti – Central Serengeti

Enjoy an early morning game drive in the Northern Serengeti, giving you another opportunity to witness river crossings or predator activity. Later, begin your journey back to the Central Serengeti with game viewing en route. This return allows you to capture different landscapes and wildlife perspectives as you transition back through the park.

Accommodation: Robin Camp - Serengeti - Central

DAY 9

25th Sept: Serengeti – Ngorongoro Conservation Area (NCAA)

After breakfast, enjoy a final morning game drive in the Serengeti before departing toward the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The drive offers scenic views and possible wildlife sightings along the way. Arrive at the beautiful Farm House Lodge for your overnight stay, surrounded by lush coffee plantations and highland scenery — a perfect place to relax after the vast Serengeti plains.

Accommodation: Farm House - Ngorongoro

DAY 10

26th Sept: Ngorongoro Crater – Return to Arusha / Airport / Zanzibar

Early in the morning, descend into the world-famous Ngorongoro Crater for a half-day game drive. The crater floor is home to an incredible concentration of wildlife including elephants, lions, buffalo, flamingos, and the rare black rhino. After your game drive, ascend the crater and drive back to Arusha or Kilimanjaro International Airport for your onward flight to Zanzibar. It is important to note that your departure flight should be scheduled in the evening to allow sufficient time for the crater experience and transfer.
