Day 2

Walking Safari with a Maasai Guide & Bush Lunch

This immersive experience allows you to explore the African bush in the most authentic way—on foot, just as the Maasai have done for centuries.

During the walk, your guide will introduce you to the region's diverse flora and fauna, explaining the medicinal uses of various plants and how the Maasai coexist with wildlife. You will also learn ancient tracking techniques and hear fascinating stories about Maasai warriors and their encounters with wild animals. As midday approaches, you will arrive at a picturesque spot in the wilderness where a bush lunch will be served. Surrounded by breathtaking landscapes, enjoy a delicious meal prepared using fresh, locally sourced ingredients. After some relaxation, you will walk back to the lodge, where you can spend the afternoon at leisure, perhaps engaging in beadwork with Maasai women or simply unwinding with a book.

As evening falls, a traditional Maasai storytelling session awaits, offering deeper insights into their customs, beliefs, and way of life. End your day with a warm dinner under the starry African sky before retreating to your room for a restful night.

Day 3

Spear Throwing, Maasai Boma Visit & Sundowner in Maasailand

After an early breakfast, the morning begins with an exhilarating spear-throwing competition with Maasai warriors. This activity is not just for fun but is a crucial skill in Maasai culture, once used for hunting and self-defense. The Maasai warriors will demonstrate the proper techniques, and you'll have the chance to test your skills under their guidance. It's a thrilling experience that gives you a taste of Maasai warrior training.

After some relaxation at the lodge, the afternoon takes you deep into Maasai culture with a visit to a traditional Maasai boma (village). Here, you will get a firsthand look at the daily lives of the Maasai people, from their iconic Manyatta (mud hut) homes to their intricate beadwork and livestock-keeping traditions. You will meet Maasai families, interact with the elders, and even take part in daily activities such as milking cows or learning how to make fire using traditional methods.

As the sun begins to set, you will be taken to a breathtaking viewpoint for a sundowner experience. With a glass of wine, fresh juice, or a cold beer in hand, you will watch the

sun dip below the horizon, casting golden hues over the endless plains of Maasailand. This magical moment, accompanied by the distant sounds of cattle and Maasai songs, is the perfect way to reflect on the incredible cultural journey you've experienced so far. Return to the lodge for your final dinner, followed by a relaxing night's sleep.
