Itinerary

Day 1

Moshi - Arusha National Park for Walking Safari

Depart Arusha at 08.00 am for a 30 minutes drive to Arusha National Park. Here you will participate in a half-day walking safari and a half-day game drive. You will be accompanied by an armed ranger for the walk, who will guide you through the forest up to the waterfall and the point for viewing the black and white colobus monkeys. During the game drive, you will see the 7 Lakes of Momella and the Ngurduto Crater. At sunset, you will return to camp/lodge for dinner and overnight.

Accommodation: *Kibo Palace Hotel - Arusha*

Day 2

Arusha - Tarangire National Park

After an early breakfast, you set off from your lodge as the morning light begins to warm the African plains. A scenic drive of about 90 minutes brings you to Tarangire National Park, a land shaped by ancient baobab trees and the life-giving Tarangire River. Often called the home of elephants, this park offers unforgettable sightings of large elephant families gathering along the riverbanks, moving with quiet power and grace. As the day unfolds, keep your eyes open for lions resting in the shade, elusive leopards draped over tree branches, graceful giraffes browsing the treetops, and—if luck smiles—even the rare sight of tree-climbing pythons. Tarangire is wild, raw, and wonderfully timeless—just the way a true safari should be.

Accommodation: *Acacia Farm Lodge - Karatu*

Day 3

Tarangire - Serengeti National Park

An early breakfast at 7:00 am sets the rhythm for a classic safari morning as you head out with the rising sun. The drive toward Serengeti National Park becomes a game drive in itself, with wildlife encounters unfolding along the way. Soon, the legendary Serengeti reveals itself—Tanzania’s largest and most celebrated national park, famous across the world for its endless plains and the dramatic movement of the Great Wildebeest Migration. This vast wilderness is ruled by powerful lion prides and skilled predators such as cheetahs, leopards, and hyenas, all moving to the ancient rhythms of the land. Every mile brings a new story, and by the time you arrive, the Serengeti already feels alive beneath your wheels.

Day 4

Serengeti - Ngorongoro Conservation Area

Another rewarding game drive in the Serengeti fills the morning with final wildlife encounters before you begin your afternoon journey toward the Ngorongoro area, with an optional stop at Olduvai Gorge to explore this remarkable cradle of human history. As the landscape changes from open plains to rolling highlands, you continue to Ngorongoro Farm House for dinner and overnight. Located just outside the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, this charming lodge is set amid beautiful countryside, offering wide views of farmland, forested hills, and open skies. It is a peaceful and comfortable retreat, perfectly placed to relax and reflect on the day’s adventure before your descent into the crater the following morning.

Day 5

Ngorongoro Crater

A full day unfolds inside the breathtaking Ngorongoro Crater, a natural wonder where wildlife thrives within ancient volcanic walls. As you descend to the crater floor, the chances of spotting the legendary Big Five in a single day are exceptionally high—lions lounging in the grass, rare black rhinos moving quietly across the plains, towering elephants, powerful buffalo, and the elusive leopard watching from the shadows. Midday, you pause for a picnic lunch surrounded by this extraordinary setting, with wildlife never far from view. In the afternoon, you ascend from the crater and continue toward the Great Rift Valley, arriving at your lodge perched high above the landscape, where sweeping views over Lake Manyara and the valley below provide a peaceful and memorable end to an unforgettable safari day.

Accommodation: *Lake Manyara Serena Safari Lodge*

Day 6

Lake Manyara National Park - Arusha

A full day is spent exploring the lush beauty of Lake Manyara National Park, a small yet remarkably diverse gem tucked beneath the Great Rift Valley escarpment. The day begins with an early sunrise game drive, when the forest is alive with movement and the light filters softly through the trees. This park is celebrated for its rich birdlife, playful baboons, pods of hippos, and the famous tree-climbing lions resting among the branches. A picnic lunch is enjoyed within the park, surrounded by green landscapes and wildlife sounds. In the afternoon, you depart Lake Manyara and drive back to Arusha, carrying with you the final memories of a safari filled with contrast, color, and timeless moments in the wild.
